- All new Internet data update mechanism
- Tool tips on airspace in the profile view
- SIDS/ STARS support through a route wizard
- Full mirroring of DUATS database used as foundation to improve data matches to DUATS briefings
- TFR list instant access by “right-click” on any TFR
- Auto-notification of updated new application
- Ability to add sectionals, TACs, WACs, Low/High Enroutes and terminal procedures to the product

Since Golden Eagle 2007 is a major release, when you update or install over a prior version of Golden Eagle, it will create a new folder and copy your profiles/flightplans from your old GoldenEagle installation. Once you insure that everything transferred to the new Golden Eagle, you can remove your old Golden Eagle program and folders.

DUATS on iPhone™

Apple’s revolutionary new iPhone™ has a full function browser that allows for CSC DUATS to be fully utilized. Simply type in www.duats.com and you will see the full Web DUATS home page.

You can enlarge the page to make it easier to select input boxes. Any input box selected will automatically offer keyboard functions for alphanumeric input. Type an input or select a drop-down, hit “go” and you get; weather graphics, weather along your route, an auto-generated flight log and then you can file your flight plan.

Everything you can do on a desktop or laptop you can do using the browser on iPhone™. Using this new technology, you get WebDUATS, phone, e-mail, and much more on a easy to use single device.

Notice on Filing Flight Plans in the Gulf of Mexico

CSC DUATS has been approved by Houston Center for filing IFR flight plans to and from the Gulf of Mexico. Flight plans originating or terminating in the Gulf of Mexico using either Lat/Long or FIXs for departures/arrivals are accepted.

The IFR flight plan must fall within Houston Center airspace and/or their Oceanic airspace.

Golden Eagle and Windows Vista Compatibility

Please follow the steps below to properly set up Golden Eagle FlightPrep® 2007 to run under Windows Vista.

1. Download and install the latest version of Golden Eagle 2007 (Approx 42 MB).
2. Clicking on the download “Install Shield” will install Golden Eagle. Once the software has been installed, right-click on the “Golden Eagle by FlightPrep®” desktop shortcut, and select “Properties.”
3. In the “Properties” dialog (see graphic on back), select “Compatibility,” then set the following settings:
 - a. Under the “Compatibility” mode section, select “Run this program in compatibility mode for: Windows XP (Service Pack 2).”
 - b. Under the “Privilege Level” section, select “Run this program as administrator.”
 - c. Select “OK” to confirm your selections and close the “Properties” dialog.

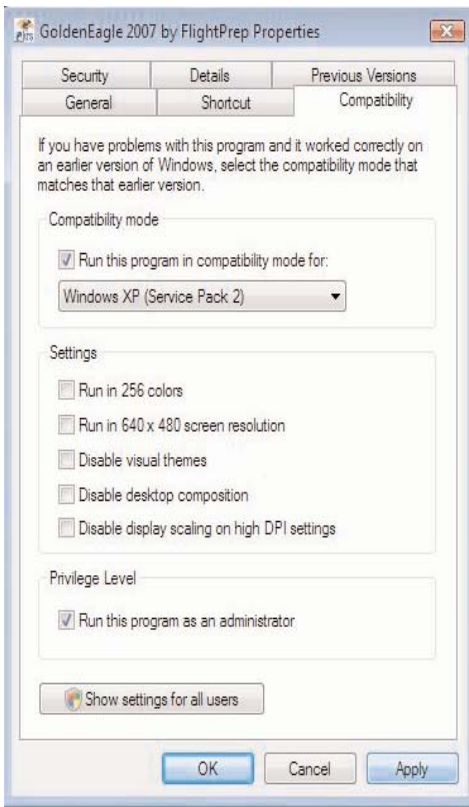

- Double-click on the Golden Eagle 2007 by FlightPrep® shortcut to launch the application. When the application launches, you will be asked to confirm access to your computer. Select “Allow” to run the application.



New Washington, DC ADIZ Effective 30 August 2007

The new ADIZ is much smaller and affects fewer airports and instead of entry/exit “points,” you now have gates. The intention of the gate is to preclude every flight entering and exiting at a single point.

The FAA detailed instructions are included in the help file on Golden Eagle and via a link at the top of the flight plan filing form in Web DUATS. Pilots should review the procedures prior to flying in the ADIZ.

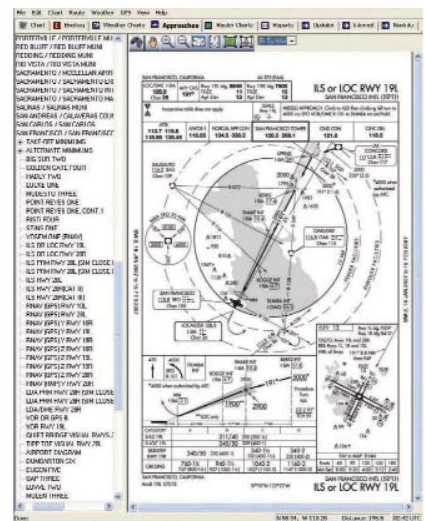
